



A **gear** or **cogwheel** is a rotating machine part having cut teeth, or **cogs**, which mesh with another toothed part to transmit rotational force.

Pendulum Swing

Oscillate - move or swing back and forth at a regular speed.
("a pendulum oscillates about its lowest point")



Quartz is a mineral in the form of a hard, shiny crystal. It is used in making electronic equipment and very accurate watches and clocks.

Hearth - the floor of a fireplace.

Stiff - not easily bent or changed in shape; rigid.



Hourglass - a device with two connected glass bulbs containing sand that takes an hour to pass from the upper to the lower bulb.



Scythe - a tool used for cutting crops such as grass or wheat.



Chime - (of a bell or clock) to make melodious ringing sounds



Stove - an apparatus for cooking or heating that operates by burning fuel or using electricity.

Amateur - nonprofessional, a person who engages in a pursuit, especially a sport, on an unpaid basis.



Scowl - frown in an angry or bad-tempered way

Snag - an unexpected obstacle.

Strain - to make unusually great effort.

Hastily - with excessive speed or urgency, hurriedly.
